Victor G.	Casey: Imsizer needs a lot of memory if you want to resize 4mb+ images. (You probally would never do it, but i got stumpled by it once)

	Anyone have suggestions for dealing with large file uploads for clients (60MB+). Video in most cases
	thinking just giving them FTP access and then having them include the file name inside the EE CP
Victor G.	FTP..
	HTTP can never do it
Ryan I.	heh, yeah FTP :)
Victor G.	unless you use flash
	and even that tends to break
Casey R.	a flash uploaded?
Timo K.	i sort of used the method described here...: http://www.darrenhoyt.com/2008/10/22/creat...
Ryan I.	you could do it with HTTP, but it can be painful
Victor G.	a flash uploader (which actually still "Posts" to a php file, so your PHP limit would also need to raised)
Ryan I.	make sure PHP is set up to allow large uploads
Casey R.	is there a php function for ftp_connect or something. so you can pass things via FTP instead of HTTP..>
Victor G.	no, HTTP can only "POST" aka SEND to HTTP
Timo K.	there they use the "TimThumb" function for resizing... any opinions about that?

Victor G.	Never used it, can't comment about it
Timo K.	well, thank you very much for all your help!
Casey R.	thinking FTP will be the way to go. For some reason they are resisting just using a hosted video service Vimeo Plus would be perfect. Clients :)
